



PUPIL PREMIUM: APRIL 2016

Pupil premium is money allocated to school for those children known to be eligible for free school meals to reduce inequality between pupils. School receives £1320 per eligible child, which helps ensure sufficient pupil support within the classroom, enrichment opportunities before, during and after school and an enhanced curriculum.

Following the introduction of the Universal Free School Meal for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children the number of applications for free school meals has decreased and therefore the funding school receives has decreased. It is vitally important that if you are eligible for free school meals regardless of whether your child receives a universal free school meal that you apply.

Your child may attract pupil premium funding if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit

In addition to pupil support, enrichment opportunities and an enhanced curriculum, we would like to support Pupil Premium children by providing:

- Free school meals.
- Free daily milk.
- Free access to breakfast club from 8am (limited availability, please see Mrs Clennell for details)
- 1 free school jumper and polo shirt per year available to order in the summer term ready for September.
- 1 free book bag.
- Subsidy towards school trips.

To ensure you and your child receive the benefits you are entitled to, please complete the attached free school meal application and return it to school as soon as possible. Please note you are no longer required to complete these forms every year as free school meal eligibility guarantees pupil premium funding for the school for the next 6 years.
