Am I entitled to the 30 hours extended childcare offer as a working parent?

From September 2017 some three and four year olds will be eligible for a funded early education place for 30 hours a week. To be eligible for 30 hours you must earn less than £100,000 and meet one of the following criteria:

- Single parents who work at least 16 hours or earns more than £115.20 / £111.20*
- Couple where both parents work at least 16 hrs/week or both earn more than £115.20/ £111.20*
- Working will include those on statutory sick pay, parental, adoption, maternity or paternity leave
- One parent is employed and the other parent is in receipt of specific carers' disability or incapacity benefits.

* These weekly amounts are based on working 16 hours at the Living / Minimum Wage which is different for different ages i.e. at 25 years you need to earn at least £115.20 per week, for 21 to 24 year olds this will be at least £111.20 per week and a lower rate again for under 21's
