<p>Summary of activities e.g. talking to staff and pupils, looking at resources, had lunch etc.</p> I watched Year 4's lesson on developing descriptive writing. I talked to the children and looked at their books and some resources. I also had a copy of the teacher's planning.	
<p>What have I learned as a result of my visit?</p> I have learned more about how Talk for Writing is used in the classroom e. g adapting or imitating writing, use of 'magpie' words, shared writing. These techniques helped the children develop skill and confidence in writing.
