Uniform Policy 2016-2017

School Uniform



All items of uniform and P.E. kit should be clearly labelled with your child's name. The uniform is as follows:

- Royal Blue jumper, cardigan or sweatshirt with school logo;
- Black, dark grey or navy trousers or skirt;
- Yellow or light blue polo shirt;
- Sensible (no heels) black shoes (see reverse)
- Blue/white or yellow/white checked dresses (optional in Summer term);
- Short trousers (optional in Summer term).
- A school book bag (purchase using school online system).

PE Kit

All children are expected to take part in P.E. Lessons should only be missed in exceptional circumstances with written permission.

Children are expected to have P.E. kits in school every day in readiness for P.E. lessons. The P.E. kit is as follows:

- Plain blue/yellow/white t-shirt;
- Dark (blue/black) shorts or tracksuit trousers;
- Black plimsolls for indoors;
- Trainers for outdoors.
- No football strips are to be worn for P.E.



Swimming Kit

Children must come prepared for swimming lessons bringing the following:

- Towel
- Girls - swimming costume (no bikinis)
- Boys – swimming shorts (not below the knee)

Jewellery and Makeup

Children are not allowed to wear any jewellery including earrings of any kind.

Makeup is also not permitted, including nail varnish.

Consequences of not following uniform policy:

Failure to wear the correct uniform (clothes):

- Text will be sent to parents
- Child will miss their playtime and lunchtime
- If this continues for more than one day, parents will be invited to school to speak to the Head teacher, Deputy or Assistant Head teacher.

Failure to wear the correct shoes

- Text will be sent to parents
- Child will be provided with a pair of sandshoes, which they will wear for the day.
- If this continues for more than one day, parents will be invited to school to speak to the Head teacher, Deputy or Assistant Head teacher.

Failure to bring in the correct PE kit

- Text will be sent to parents
- On the first occasion the school will provide a PE kit.
- On the second occasion the child will miss their PE lesson and be provided with alternative work.
- Parents will be invited to school to speak to the Head teacher, Deputy or Assistant Head teacher.

Wearing jewellery or makeup

- Text will be sent to parents
- Wipes will be provided by the school to remove make-up and nail varnish.
- Gel nails are not permitted and if worn, they will need to be removed by the parents. The child will miss their break and lunch until they are removed.
- Jewellery will be removed and taken to the office, parents to collect it at the end of the day.
- If this continues for more than one day, parents will be invited to school to speak to the Head teacher, Deputy or Assistant Head teacher.
