

<u>Literacy</u>

In Literacy, using a Talk 4 Writing approach, we will be exploring stories with familiar settings, fairy tales and poetry. We will write our own stories using simple and compound sentences with capital letters and full stops and we will even write instructions so you can learn how to catch a dragon! In Phonics, we will focus on reading key words and sounding out tricky words.

In Maths, we will learn to estimate amounts to 100. We will revise number bonds to 10 and extend to 20, we will also learn how to double numbers. We will continue to investigate 2d shape. We will continue to compare and order numbers to 100.
