RE



In this last half term, we will look at the topics of Choices – the sacrament of reconciliation and Special places. We will also study some aspects of Islamic beliefs.

Maths



In Maths we will use the grid method to multiply 2 and 3 digit numbers by 3, 4, 5, 6 and 8 and to divide using chunking with and without remainders. We will also continue to study fractions and recognise tenths and equivalent fractions as well as finding one tenth of single digit numbers. In Geometry we will identify, name and draw different lines and angles and explore symmetry in 2d shapes. We will continue to tell the time using both analogue and digital clocks to the nearest minute.

History

Our history topic this term is on the Romans will include a field trip to Segedunum. The emphasis will be on life in Britain and the legacy left behind by the Romans.



P.E.

In P.E. we will look at cricket and athletics with an emphasis on throwing and bowling and techniques for running and pacing.



Design Technology

We will research Roman art and design and based upon this research the children will plan and make their own mosaics using traditional patterns. They will also design a test out model catapults.

English



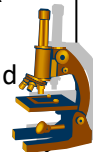
We will use our science topic volcanoes to write explanation texts and newspaper reports (on Pompeii). We will base our fiction writing on the texts - Escape from Pompeii and Rampaging Romans. Fiction writing will continue with a study of historical themes and how to use facts to write fiction.

In grammar, identification of different word groups will continue and we will also continue to enhance our work by using different sentence openers and rearranging the words.

Science

In the last half of the summer term our topic will be light and shadows.

The children will also learn how to work scientifically through a variety of investigations and learn how to pose and answer scientific questions.



ICT

We will revisit the topic of programming and continue to learn how to debug a program. We will also learn how to use a search engine to find specific information on the internet. To create an information leaflet or book about Rome and the Roman World.

French

The children will continue learning French. They will consolidate their vocabulary knowledge looking at body parts, and classroom objects and learn to answer simple questions.
