Public Sector Equality Duty

The Equality Act 2010 includes a Public Sector Equality Duty (PSED). Schools are required to publish information demonstrating how they are complying with the PSED and prepare and publish equality objectives.

At Our Lady and St Anne's our objectives are

- Promote equality of access and opportunity within our school and within our wider community.
