

Our Lady and St Anne's RC Primary School READING SCHEME



Our children access a variety of reading schemes in school. The schemes we use include:

- Oxford Reading Tree with the inclusion of Project X and Oxford Phonics
- Phonics Bugs
- Collins
- Rigby Star
- Nelson Thorne

These books cover a wide variety of fiction and non-fiction texts which are cross-curricular and compliment the national curriculum. ICT is used to support this through the Lexia and Reading Eggs schemes which are accessed both in school and at home. These are used to extend phonics and reading skills.

Better Reading Partnership is used with children who need a little more support with fluency and comprehension. This is delivered on a 1-1 basis, 3 times a week.

We are currently trialling Accelerated Reader in Year 4 and 5. Accelerated Reader is an interactive programme that encourages a love of reading in children and aims to help school foster the habit of independent reading among pupils of all abilities. The children's understanding and enjoyment of the books they have read are measured through a series of mini quizzes taken online. Reports are then produced to enable teachers to identify what kind of support is needed for each child to progress further. We hope to extend this trial across the whole of KS2.
