#### **Commentary**

## Phonics data at the end of Year 1 in our school in 2017

- 80% of children achieved the pass rate.
- 81% of the boys attained this compared to 79% of our girls.
- 100% of FSM pupils compared to 75% non FSM (school).
- Non EAL did better than EAL (100% v 70%)

#### **Key Stage 1 2017**

### Strengths

- Significant improvement on last year's EXS+ attainment (+24%) in Maths
- GDS improvements last year sustained in Writing and Maths
- Progress in Reading for the low prior attainment band was above the city average
- Progress in Reading for the low prior attainment band for disadvantaged pupils was above the city average
- Girls' progress was very high in Reading, Writing and Maths

### **End of Key Stage 2 Achievement 2017**

In Reading, Writing and Maths combined, 73% were at expected or above, compared to the national figure of 61%. 17% achieved GDS against the national of 9%.

In Reading 83% achieved the expected standard and 27% achieved the higher standard, compared to the national figures of 71% and 25%. Average scaled score for Reading was 104.7 compared to the national of 104.1. Reading progress was +1.72.

In Writing 83% achieved the expected standard and 23% achieved the higher standard, compared to the national figures of 76% and 18%.

In Maths 83% achieved the expected standard and 30% achieved the higher standard, compared to the national figures of 75% and 23%. Average scaled score for Maths was 106.1 compared to the national of 104.2. Maths progress was +3.28, well above national and in the top 10% of English schools.

FFT Aspire shows that in Reading and Maths our Average Scaled Score of 105.4 (national 104.1) placed us in the top 34% of schools nationally for attainment. Our progress measure in Reading and Maths was +2.5 (national 0) placing us in the top 16% of schools nationally. Our combined figure for combined Reading, Writing and Maths was 73% placing us in the top 24% of schools nationally for attainment whilst the progress measure for combined was +16% placing us in the top 13% for progress.

We were delighted with these results, which were the result of an improved curriculum, outstanding teaching and targeted intervention.

# Strengths

- Huge improvements on last year in all subjects so we now exceed national figures across the board
- High percentage of GDS in all subjects
- Boys' attainment and progress across all areas is very strong

## 2017 EYFSP scores

In 2017 we achieved 70% GLD, 77% for Reading, 70% for Writing and 77% for Maths

- Improvements are strong in GLD over time
- Disadvantaged outperformed non-disadvantaged in all areas
- Girls' attainment was very high in all areas
- Boys' attainment was very high in Maths
- Girls' GDS was high in Maths
