<p style="text-align: center;"><b>What have I learned as a result of my visit?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• I learned that the numbers of EAL pupils is increasing particularly in early years and a wider range of first languages are spoken at home.</li> <li>• EAL pupils tend to do better than other cohorts</li> <li>• Perception of what is considered as first language by pupils varies.</li> <li>• Pupils are encouraged to use first language at home; first language very much valued.</li> <li>• I learned how pupils are assessed on arrival to gain a better understanding of their needs.</li> <li>• Proactive approach to engage with EAL families through invitations to come into school and read to class in their own language.
